

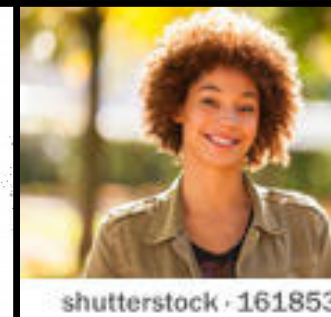
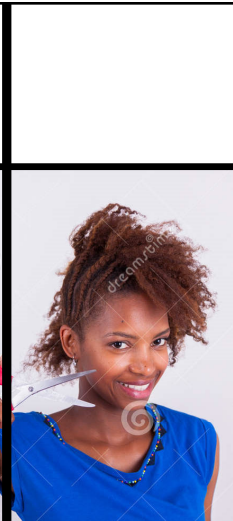

Rise of Post-Industrialism & post-soul culture (late 70's)

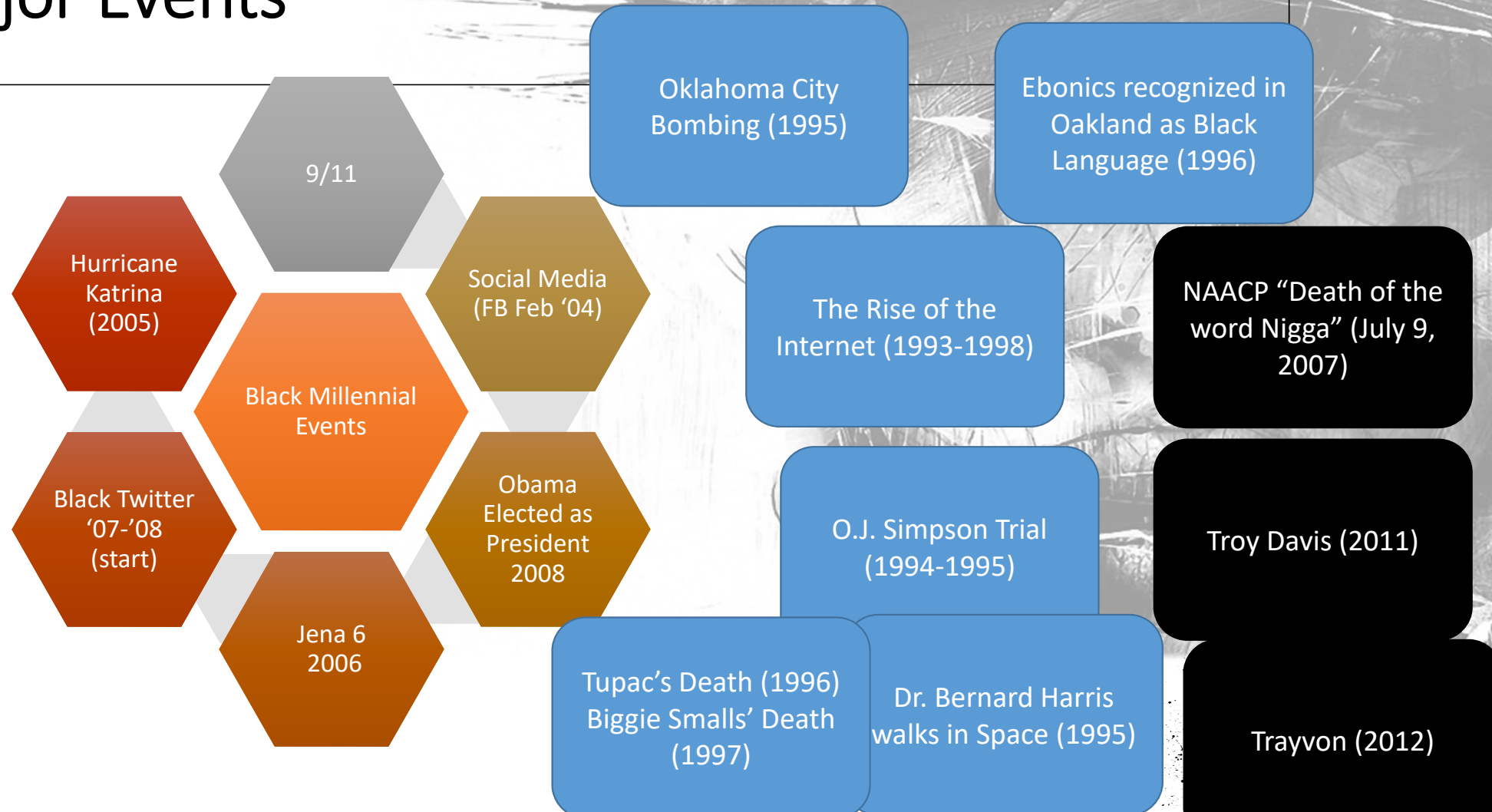
