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• Hip Hop IS... • Hip Hop is an urban sub-culture that seeks to express a <u>life-style</u>, <u>attitude</u>, and/or <u>urban individuality</u>. Hip Hop at its core—not the commercialization and commodity it has become in certain respects— <u>rejects</u> dominant forms of culture and society and seeks to increase a social consciousness along with a racial/ethnic pride. Thus, Hip Hop uses *rap music, dance, music production, MCing, and allegory* as vehicles to send and fund its message of social, cultural, and political <u>resistance</u> to dominate structures of norms



Rap (Continued)

Thus, rap is the <u>musical</u> expression that compliments the oral communication of its culture. Rap also captures and <u>esteems</u> the ghetto poor existence as valid and real to all people of color, including many poor Whites. Rap brings the <u>revenue</u>, which fuels the culture and its message.
